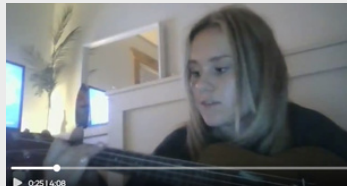
Valedictorian Kierstin Midelfort & Salutatorian Ana Velazquez

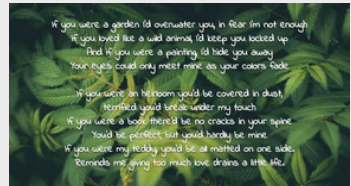

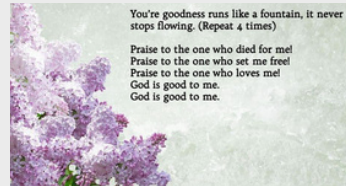

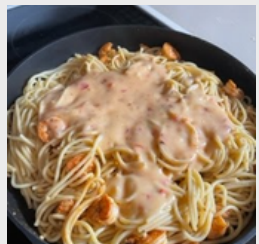
This collaborative mosaic was designed using Google Drawings and is the work of all art students in grades 6-12.

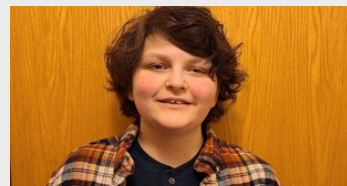

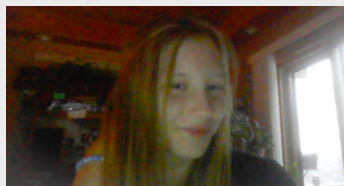

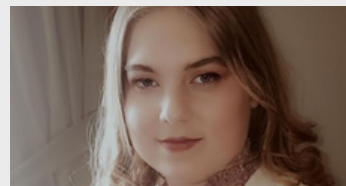
